

The ProHammer's reduced hitting surface is designed to eliminate wrist roll at contact and under-cutting of the ball, which often results in weak ground balls and pop-ups that are easily fielded.

By providing a narrow hitting surface (bat barrel), it gives quick and efficient feedback to the hitter, letting him know that he has found the "edge grain" of the bat.

Additionally, the unique shape of the barrel trains the hitter to correct and refine his path to the ball, resulting in more line-drives into fair territory.



Designed and built to hit real baseballs, the ProHammer is manufactured using top-grade materials. The alloy hitting face does not "ping" but instead produces a sound similar to a professional wood bat when striking a baseball.

## Product Description

While it is true that all game bats have a cylindrical hitting surface with potentially unlimited points of contact, the reality is that the best pro hitters consistently make ball contact along the narrow "edge grain" area of the barrel. They do this for two important reasons:

- 1) The edge grain represents the strongest area of a wood bat. Ball contact along the edge grain results in more hits and fewer broken bats.
- 2) More power and better ball control. Pro hitters train their wrists to bring the edge grain to the baseball regardless of where in the strike zone

the ball is. Power, bat speed, and ball control diminish quickly as the wrists "roll" the edge grain away from contact.

The ProHammer is configured to provide narrow contact surfaces, rapidly training the hitter to not "roll" his wrists through the hitting zone. The narrow contact surfaces have a diameter, length, and curvature that is otherwise identical to a conventional wood bat...only the portion you don't need has been removed.

The ProHammer is ideal for use in standard pro-style hitting drills, including tee-work, flips, front-toss, and thrown batting practice. It is recommended that a player switch to a game bat for hard machine pitch or hard live batting practice.
